

The Jan van Goyen Address Book

This Address Book is illustrated with 20 drawings by the famous 17th-century Dutch landscape artist Jan van Goyen (Leiden 1596 - The Hague 1656). The drawings are a selection from the sketchbook Van Goyen started to use in 1644 on his travels through the Dutch countryside.

At the end of the 19th century the sketchbook was owned by the Parisian art dealer Warneck who in 1900 presented it to the celebrated collector Dr Abraham Bredius. From there it entered the Bredius-Kronig collection, and is now on display in the Bredius Museum at Lange Vijverberg 14 in The Hague.

In 1985 several private individuals founded the Bredius Society. Among them was art dealer John Hoogsteder. This society has one objective: to ensure the wellbeing of the Bredius Museum.

With this goal in mind art dealers Hoogsteder & Hoogsteder took the initiative to produce this Address Book in 1993 and decided to donate all proceeds to the Bredius Society. It was reprinted in 1996 on the occasion of the Jan van Goyen exhibition in Stedelijk Museum De Lakenhal in Leiden.
